NEW USE FOR PUTZ LIQUIDFLOW - DIGITAL PRESSES

Putz Liquidflow, the original deglazer in the graphics arts industry, has found a new home in the digital press market. It is being used successfully to clean and extend the life of OPC and selenium drums in presses such as Xeikon, Chromapress and Nexpress. Customers report that Putz can double or triple life expectancy of OCP drums. Drums are very expensive to replace, and Putz can help save customers thousands of dollars in replacement costs.

Benefits:

- Safe and easy to use
- Non-toxic; non-flammable
- Extends the life of OPC or selenium drums

Directions for cleaning:

Apply Putz Pomade to a lint free cloth, and wipe over the drum to remove toner particles.

Follow this with a damp* (not wet), soft, lint-free cloth to remove Putz, and run about 50 sheets to prepare the unit for printing. Or, buff down dry with a soft, lint-free cloth prior to printing.

*It is important not to saturate the drum as water can get inside the end seams.
